TED TALK THEOLOGY

This summer we will view TED Talks through the lens of our faith during the Sunday School hour (9:45-10:55am). TED is a nonprofit devoted to "Ideas Worth Spreading," usually in the form of short, powerful talks (18 minutes or less). TED began in 1984 as a conference where $\underline{\text{Technology}}$, $\underline{\text{Entertainment}}$, and $\underline{\text{Design}}$ converged, and today covers almost all topics from science to business to global issues and more.

Each Sunday we will watch a different TED talk, read a corresponding passage of scripture, and discuss what they say to each other and to us about our faith and life. A team of facilitators will rotate leading each week. Many of our adult Sunday School classes are combining for this study, and we invite you to join us, too.

TED Talk Theology starts on May 26 and concludes July 28.
